

The Capstone Presentations

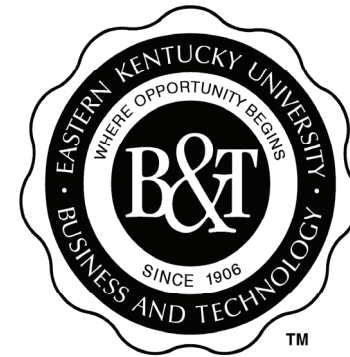
