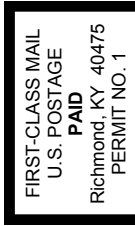

## **DR. WILL MCINTOSH**

### **Distinguished Speaker**

Will McIntosh is Managing Director for AIG Global Real Estate Investment Corp. (GREIC) with the primary responsibility for building the third party real estate investment management business. His roles include strategic planning, new product development, building a global investment research team, and marketing/client services. He also has primary responsibility for investors (including pension funds, insurance companies, endowments and foundations, and high net-worth families) in the eastern United States, Europe, and the Middle East.

Prior to joining AIG GREIC, Dr. McIntosh was Managing Director and Portfolio Manager for Prudential Real Estate Investors (PREI) International with a focus on Latin America. He was responsible for the development and operation of real estate investment management and advisory capability in Brazil for Brazilian pension funds and international investors. At PREI, Dr. McIntosh was also Managing Director of Investment Research overseeing real estate research activities for over \$13 billion in international and domestic real estate investments. His service also included the PREI Investment, Management, and International Management Committees.

While Senior Vice President and Director of Research for MIG Realty Advisors, Dr. McIntosh directed the Research Department, was Vice President of MIG Residential REIT, and served on the Investment and Management Committees.

Dr. McIntosh earned his BS in Business Education and MBA from Eastern Kentucky University. He earned his PhD in Finance and Real Estate from the University of North Texas and was Associate Professor of Finance and Real Estate and Director of the Center for Real Estate Studies in the College of Business and Economics at the University of Kentucky. He is also a graduate of the School of Mortgage Banking of the Mortgage Bankers Association of America and served as a Faculty Fellow.

In addition to his accomplishments in international real estate investment, Dr. McIntosh has also served on a variety of professional and academic advisory boards. He recently served as Co-Editor of the *Journal of Real Estate Portfolio Management* and has published numerous articles in leading real estate academic and professional journals.
